SCHEDULE OF INFRACTIONS AND PENALTIES

This schedule of infractions and penalties is in accordance with policies of the NFHS, the NYSPHSAA and Section III, and will be effective as of January 1, 2012 for all members of this organization.

The following actions are subject to penalties under the Constitution and By-laws of the Syracuse Chapter, NYSBUA.

1. Missing a full game assignment due to negligence.
2. Failure to report to the game site on time due to negligence.
3. Failure to officiate in proper uniform per applicable NFHS, NYSPHSAA and Syracuse Chapter policies.
4. Falsifying mileage charges.
5. Violating policy, as determined by the Executive Committee, regarding turning back of assignments.
6. Violating policy regarding accepting game assignments to work games in any sport if those assignments create a conflict or hardship for the Syracuse Chapter.
7. Use of tobacco products on or near (to include parking area) a NYSPHSAA playing field.
8. Any and all other actions that are not in accord with established policies of the aforementioned organizations as determined by the Executive Committee.

Examples of negligence (see #1 and #2) include, but are not limited to:

- Failure to communicate with partner to confirm game schedule information, proper uniform and travel arrangements.
- Failure to contact host school or contact person at the proper time to confirm game information.
- Failure to ascertain route and directions to game site.

PENALTIES: 1st offense -- Reprimand
2nd offense -- Fine, up to \$50
3rd offense -- Fine, up to \$100
4th offense -- Fine and/or suspension from the organization as determined by the Executive Committee
