SCHEDULE OF INFRACTIONS, FINES AND PENALTIES

This schedule of infractions, fines and penalties is in accordance with policies of the NFHS, the NYSPHSAA and Section III, and will be effective as of January 1, 2009 for all members of this organization.

The following actions are subject to penalties under the Constitution and By-laws of the Syracuse Chapter, NYSBUA.

1. Failure to report to the game site on time, due to negligence.
Examples of negligence include, but are not limited to:
 - Failure to communicate with partner to confirm game schedule information, proper uniform and travel arrangements.
 - Failure to contact host school or contact person at the proper time to confirm game information.
 - Failure to ascertain route and directions to game site.
2. Failure to officiate in proper uniform per applicable NFHS, NYSPHSAA and Syracuse Chapter policies.
3. Falsifying mileage charges.
4. Violating Syracuse Chapter policy as to turning back assignments.
5. Violating Syracuse Chapter policy by accepting assignments to work games outside the Syracuse Chapter, including softball, if those assignments create a conflict or hardship for the Syracuse Chapter.
6. Use of tobacco products on or near (to include parking area) a NYSPHSAA playing field.
7. Any and all other actions that are not in accord with established policies of the aforementioned organizations as determined by the Executive Committee.

PENALTIES: 1st offense -- written warning
2nd offense -- \$25.00 fine
3rd offense -- \$50.00 fine
4th offense -- suspension from the organization as determined by the Executive Committee
